The \$35 million project, awarded by the City of Baltimore, includes the replacement of the Maisel Street Pedestrian Bridge, Annapolis Road Bridge and Waterview Avenue Bridge. Work also includes corridor-wide guide sign replacement and Annapolis Road resurfacing.
