The Odd Fellows Road Interchange project, an approximately \$30 million design-build project for the Virginia Department of Transportation, included a new interchange along the US Route 29/460 corridor at Odd Fellows Road in Lynchburg, Virginia, consisting of a two-span bridge over existing US Route 29/460, two on-ramps, two traffic roundabouts, and the widening of an existing portion of Odd Fellows Road. Additional improvements included corridorwide utility relocations, sidewalks, a shared use path, enhanced street lighting and landscaping.
