Wagman Heavy Civil, Inc. Opens Battlefield Parkway Interchange

(York, Pa.) Wagman Heavy Civil, Inc., alongside representatives from the Town of Leesburg, Loudoun County, and the Virginia Department of Transportation, celebrated the opening of the Route 7 and Battlefield Parkway interchange in Leesburg, Virginia, at a ribbon cutting ceremony on Monday, June 28, 2021.

As one of the busiest commuter routes in the area, the new interchange provides traffic congestion relief, allowing vehicles to travel Route 7 with ease. Wagman constructed the new bridge over Route 7 and the associated ramps in under a year, prior to the July 4th holiday, as planned.

"In our line of work, we are used to planning, and often adapt our plans to overcome variables, such as extreme weather.
