Wagman Construction has been selected as the general contractor for WellSpan Health's new acute care hospital in Shrewsbury. The 18,000 SF facility will include a 24/7 emergency department, ten inpatient beds, and diagnostic services such as ultrasound, CT, X-ray, and lab work—all designed to expand access to quality healthcare in the region.

Progress on site continues to move steadily. Crews have completed the building slab and underground utility work, along with key site infrastructure including stormwater

systems, curbs, and water and electric lines. Major equipment such as the air handling unit has been delivered, and masonry work is underway in support areas. The stone base for the parking lot has been laid, with perimeter sidewalk installation beginning soon. Steel erection is scheduled to start in early June.

The hospital is on track to open in early 2026, bringing essential services closer to the southern York County community.

PROJECT UPDATE

Wagman, Inc. Headquarters Renovations

Wagman is renovating a building, designed by Warehaus, at 3265 Farmtrail Road in York, PA. Once complete, this will be the new main office for Wagman, Inc., Wagman Construction, Inc., and Wagman Heavy Civil, Inc., including the Geotechnical operations for the northern region.

The building was originally constructed by Wagman Construction and is being updated to better meet the company's current and future needs. Renovations include:

- Interior demolition and reconfiguration of office spaces
- · Upgrades to mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems
- · New finishes throughout the building
- · Exterior improvements, including expanded parking and landscaping

The move also allows Wagman to expand its Field Service Center, which will continue operating at the current 3290 North Susquehanna Trail location.

Work is expected to wrap up later this year.





PROJECT UPDATE

York Academy Regional Charter School North Beaver Street Facility Renovations

Wagman Construction is working on a renovation and expansion project for York Academy Regional Charter School's Upper School Legacy Hall. The project involves turning an abandoned building into usable classroom space.

The project involves constructing new rooms within the existing open space, along with restrooms and stairways, while upgrading plumbing, mechanical, and electrical systems throughout the building. Additionally, a small expansion will increase the overall square footage.

One of the challenges on this project is working around the building's original barrel-vaulted brick ceilings. While visually striking, the ceilings made it more difficult to route utilities like piping and conduit throughout the space, requiring careful planning and coordination.

The project is expected to be completed by July 2025.
